Message From Initiator



It was 2015. Development Activist Mohua Apa called me one day and said that a boy had been admitted to Dhaka College. Still, due to a lack of financial means, he was unable to continue his education. She insisted, “Will it be possible for you to help the boy?” Without thinking, I requested Mohua Apa to send the boy immediately; I said, “I will try my best.”

A few days later, a gentleman, along with a boy, came to meet with me. The gentleman was a driver by profession. At one point in the discussion, I found that the boy’s house was just beside my hometown. The name of the boy was Ripon. After hearing all this, I assured him and started helping him with one thousand taka per month to continue his education. After listening to the life incident of Ripon, I felt a kind of pain inside me. Some past memories occupied me for a few moments. At that time, I decided I would support him as much as I could till the completion of Master’s Education instead of a one-time support.

In 2018, I was travelling to Thailand for emergency work with my only son Sikder Asif Rumi. We used to call him Rumi, and he was only ten years old at that time. One day, I was walking back to the hotel with my son after some shopping. Both of my hands were full of bags, so I couldn’t hold him. Suddenly, I saw that Rumi was not there. I looked around, but couldn’t find him. I became restless and worried. Going back a little, I saw Rumi taking coins out of his pocket. He gave all the coins to a poor man lying on the side of the road. The man also had a little boy with him. “What’s up, Dad?” I asked. Rumi said, “Dad, the man is very poor, so I gave the coins to him. The boy wanted them too. They have to eat, and the boy will study.”

Rumi accumulated a lot of coins in the last few days. Coins are his favorite. He used to tell me, “Dad, I will save all the coins. It’s my hobby.” “I’ve wanted to spend the coins many times. He did not agree to it at all. But now he gave them his favorite coins?” I was surprised by the words of my ten-year-old son. I also felt ashamed. That incident that day made my life different, which has helped me to take this initiative today.

Let's go back a little to my childhood. I don't remember the age. But I remember that, I couldn't understand too much at that time. My father was kind-hearted and lived in the village at that time. The family was dependent on the grandfather's wealth. We are six brothers and sisters. Though there were enough resources, the cash flow was low. So we barely managed the education costs. Many of our small urges could not be fulfilled. In the meantime, my naive father took on the responsibility of educating many orphans. I still remember one rainy season when my father sailed to another village to find the education of orphans. I was also with my father, helping him to row the boat. Father arranged for many children to be admitted to government orphanages. Although my father could not look after his children properly, he arranged the education of poor or orphaned children. That is to say, there is a link between my family tradition and today's initiative, which is genetic.

Year 2019, basically I am a development worker. My life is about social work and my ambition is to serve the distressed people of the country. The grief of the poor people of the country makes me think. The plight of disadvantaged poor families is really painful. Children are deprived of education due to the financial crisis and these families remain poor for generations. It seems to me, if one can be educated in a family, then the financial situation of the whole family changes. Future generations will be educated. An educated man can give the gift of an educated family to build a well-educated and self-reliant Bangladesh. From these thoughts, it seems that I need to give this small venture an institutional form and I need to involve many more people in this venture. That is why I named the initiative "Shwapnojatra". The beginning of a dream.

LOGO DEFINITION



Shwapnojatra

Shwapnojatra is an educational program for the less fortunate youth in Bangladesh and has helped countless young people and teens in getting proper education. The program has an adequate logo as well. Here's what it means:

Golden Door

The open door represents awaiting opportunities. The gold refers to the positive possibilities ahead for the students. It surrounds the other components of the logo as a symbolic assurance of protection and a symbol of promise for the students struggling through the hard times that the better times are ahead.

Blue Butterfly

Blue is often associated with freedom as it is the color of the sky on a bright sunny morning. The butterfly represents youth and prosperity. Butterfly motifs, historically, also represent good luck and love. The blue butterfly through the golden window is a reflection of the young, youthful individuals who reclaim their freedom through education and snag the awaiting opportunities, being independent and free from the dark bounds of ignorance and poverty.

White Book

White represents peace and innocence, and purity. The white book refers to the pure knowledge provided by the program, with the hopes of making a change for the better in society. The butterfly also blends in with the background of the logo. This program is for the youth, so the white color represents the fresh perspective of the youth and their immense adaptability to accept changes and face challenges by giving the impression of a blank slate. White color is also considered to be a natural reflector, which means the light of all seven colors of the rainbow combined makes a white light. In that sense, white is also the representation of inclusivity and the diverse beneficiaries of the program.

সোনালি দরজা

নীল প্রজাপতি

নীল সবসময়ই স্বাধীনতার প্রতীক, যা সবসময় একটি রৌদ্রোজ্জ্বল নতুন সকালের বার্তা বহন করে। প্রজাপতি তারুণ্য এবং সমৃদ্ধির প্রতিনিধিত্ব করে। প্রজাপতি সুন্দর ডিজাইন চিরাচরিতভাবে সবসময়ই সৌভাগ্য এবং ভালোবাসার প্রতিনিধিত্ব করে। সোনালি জানালার ভেতর নীল প্রজাপতি তারুণ্যের প্রতিচ্ছবি, যা প্রত্যেক উদ্যমী তরুণকে শিক্ষার মাধ্যমে নিজের লক্ষ্য অর্জন, স্বাধীনতা পুনরুদ্ধার, আত্মনির্ভরশীল এবং অজ্ঞতা ও দারিদ্র্যের বেড়াজাল থেকে নিজেকে মুক্ত করার নির্দেশনা প্রদান করে।

সাদা বই

সাদা সুখ-শান্তি ও শুদ্ধতার প্রতীক। সাদা বইটি এই কার্যক্রমের মাধ্যমে প্রদানকৃত জ্ঞানকে সঠিকভাবে কাজে লাগিয়ে একটি সুন্দর সমাজ গড়ার প্রত্যাশা বহন করে। প্রজাপতিটিও লোগোর পটভূমির সাথে ওতপ্রোতভাবে মিশে যায়; এই প্রোগ্রামটি তরুণদের জন্য, তাই সাদা রং তরুণদের নতুন দৃষ্টিভঙ্গি এবং যে কোনো ধরনের পরিবর্তন ও চ্যালেঞ্জের সাথে তরুণদের নিজেদেরকে খাপ খাইয়ে নেওয়ার মানসিকতাকে বইয়ের ভেতরের ফাঁকা অংশের কথা বলা হয়েছে। এছাড়াও সাদা রং একটি প্রাকৃতিক প্রতিফলক হিসাবে বিবেচিত হয়, যার অর্থ রংধনুর সাতটি রঙের আলো একত্রিত হয়ে একটি সাদা আলো তৈরি করে। সেই অর্থে, সাদা রং এই কার্যক্রমের সবস্তরের শিক্ষার্থীদের অংশগ্রহণ ও বৈচিত্র্যতাও নির্দেশ করে।

AN OVERVIEW OF SHWAPNOJATRA

BACKGROUND

Shwapnojatra is an education support program for poor meritorious students based on their needs, with the aim of empowering underprivileged but talented students in Bangladesh to achieve their aspirations for higher education. The necessity of such a program becomes clear when we consider the educational landscape of Bangladesh. As of 2019, the primary school dropout rate stood at 17.9%, while 36.73% of students dropped out at the secondary level. Among them, 41% of female students and 33% of male students discontinued their education, largely due to financial hardship. In the case of higher education, although exact national dropout figures are scarce, financial constraints were cited as a leading cause preventing many students from completing their studies. These alarming figures highlight the urgent need for targeted educational support for students from low-income backgrounds.

In response to this critical issue and with a vision to reduce the dropout rate across educational levels, Shwapnojatra was launched in 2019 with just 15 students. The program saw remarkable growth in subsequent years, supporting 50 students in the FY-2019-20 and 101 students in the FY 2020-21.

Since its inception, it has significantly expanded in both scale and impact, becoming a vital initiative in bridging the educational opportunity gap for underprivileged students in Bangladesh.

At its essence, Shwapnojatra is dedicated to aid students from economically disadvantaged families, helping them progress in their academic journey from primary school to higher education. The assistance provided is thoughtfully tailored to meet the individual needs of each student and includes monthly support covering session fees, tuition, examination fees, books, notebooks, writing materials, uniforms, meals, and transportation expenses. All financial aid is securely disbursed through the mobile financial service provider, Nagad.

For the fiscal year 2024–2025, Shwapnojatra has supported a total of 175 students (118 males and 57 females) attending 124 educational institutions across 46 districts of Bangladesh. These institutions range from schools, colleges, and madrasahs to medical colleges, polytechnic institutes, and universities.

A significant accomplishment of the program is that 15 students have successfully graduated from higher education. Among these, 2 are medical graduates, and 8 have secured employment in various organizations. Notably, one student has joined Ambala Foundation, really a great milestone for us, the student whose education was about to stop but now he has completed his education and is working with us.

In the fiscal year 2024–2025, Shwapnojatra supported students with an amount of BDT. 54,25,814. As Shwapnojatra continues to grow, it remains firmly rooted in the belief that education is not merely a right but a powerful means to break the cycle of poverty and build a brighter future.

To ensure transparency, accountability, and effective implementation, the program is monitored through various dedicated forums, including the Guardian

Forum, Journalist and Media Forum, and the Teachers' Forum. These platforms play a crucial role in overseeing the program's operations and maintaining continuous engagement with all stakeholders.

Looking ahead, we remain steadfast in our mission to empower underprivileged students through education. While Shwapnojatra is currently supporting students from 47 districts, we aspire to expand our reach to all 64 districts of Bangladesh. This vision fuels our continuous efforts to broaden our support network, ensuring that no deserving student is left behind due to financial barriers. By strengthening partnerships and mobilizing greater resources, we aim to turn this dream into a reality, bringing hope, opportunity, and transformation to every corner of the nation.

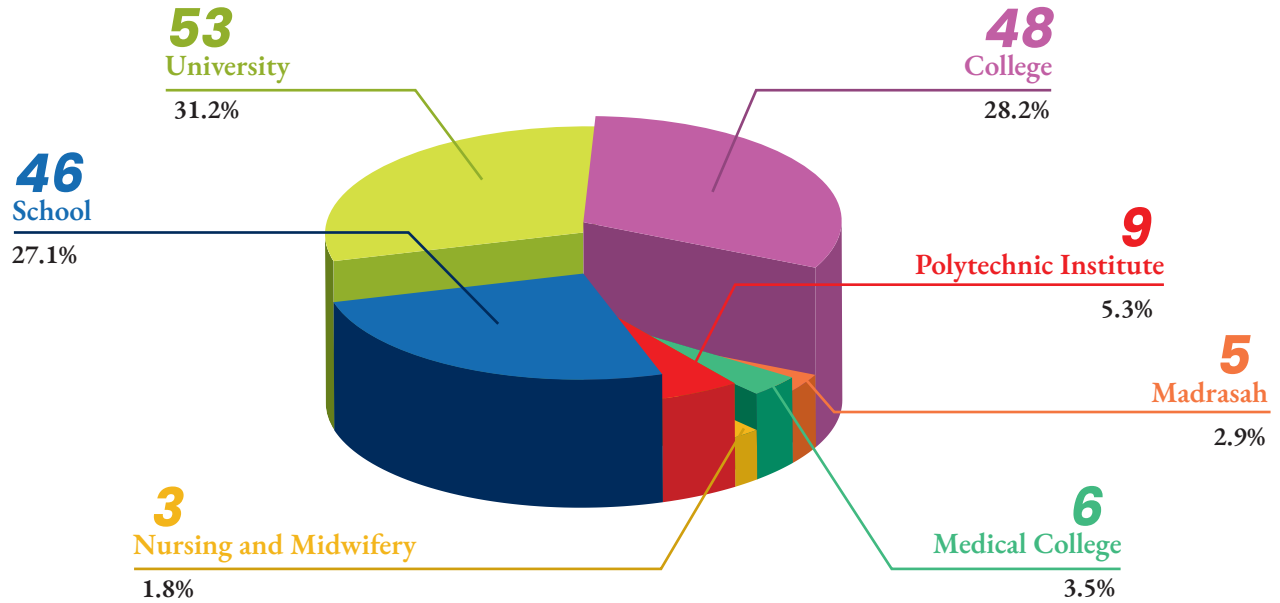

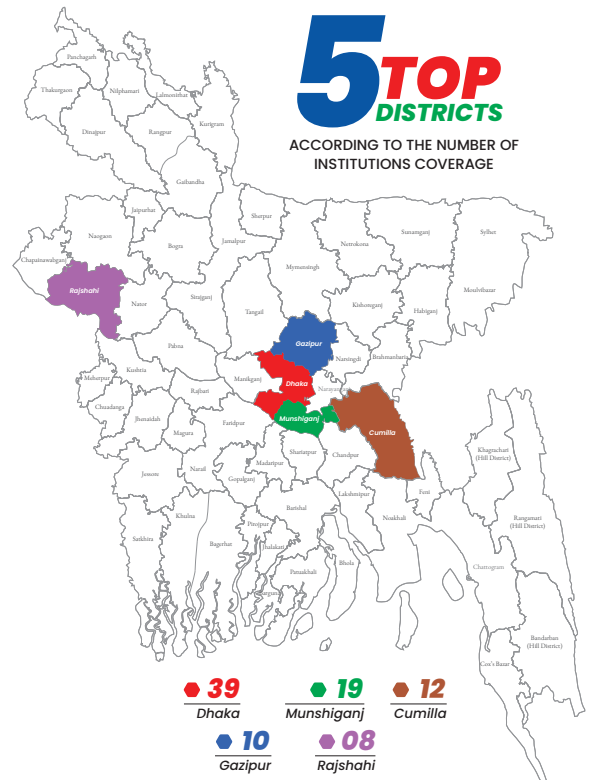

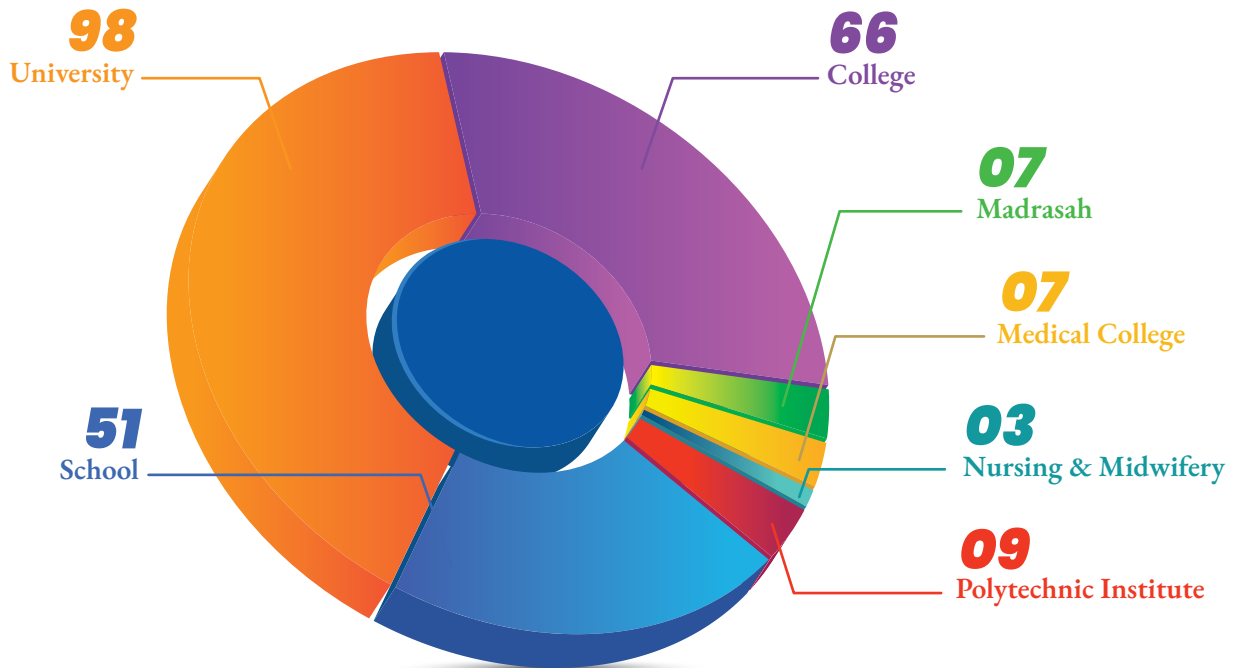

Shwapnojatra became the light in Khademul's darkness

Dreams Come into Reality

I am Khademul Islam, the son of Abdur Razzak and Khadija Begum (late). I spent my childhood in Rahimapur village, Rangpur district under Taraganj upazila. My father is a marginal farmer; we do not have any land for cultivation. My father works on others' land as a labourer for cultivation. My mother was a housewife, but she is no more with us today. A shadow of darkness has fallen on our family after the death of our mother. My Father's life's struggle, cultivating other people's land, as well as taking care of our four siblings, he had to work hard to juggle everything together.

My three elder sisters could not continue their studies after SSC due to a financial crisis. Two of my elder sisters got married at a very young age. My other sister has been suffering from mental illness since 2012. In 2022, she went missing. But by the grace of the Almighty, we were able to find her in a village beside ours. My sister's illness has been taking a toll on me since I was a teenager. Yet my good results since childhood have always made my father hopeful. I passed the HSC exam with GPA-5. But then the uncertainty started. Despite this uncertainty, I continued to dream of attending a public university. And start preparing myself. In 2019, I got an opportunity to get admitted to Dhaka University's 'B' unit in the Bengali department. But my father couldn't bear the expenses of others in the family and my admission fee altogether.

In addition, because of my sister's mental disability, her medical expenses and financial crisis, my admission is uncertain. Finally, when the admission date came, my hope gradually turned into despair. At that moment, 'Shwapnojatra' came to my side as a beacon of light. They read my life story in the newspaper and contacted me.

They paid the full cost of my admission to Dhaka University. Since I got admission to my dream university in 2020, I have been supported by Shwapnojatra. But 'Shwapnojatra' didn't just cover my admission fees; rather, they provided me with financial support every month, which is helping me to continue my studies.

During Corona, when unrest was at its peak, 'Shwapnojatra' helped us with monthly financial support. They have been bearing all the expenses of my studies from 2020 to date, which is very helpful for me. Recently, I completed my graduation, obtaining 3.46 out of 4.00 in the Bengali Department of Dhaka University. I am currently pursuing a master's in the same subject at my university. 'Shwapnojatra' has made the path to fulfill my dreams much easier. With their help, my department's results have also become relatively good.

'Shwapnojatra' has stood by me in fulfilling my dreams. They freed me from financial uncertainty and showed me the way forward towards my dreams. I am grateful to Shwapnojatra because they are a part of my dreams."

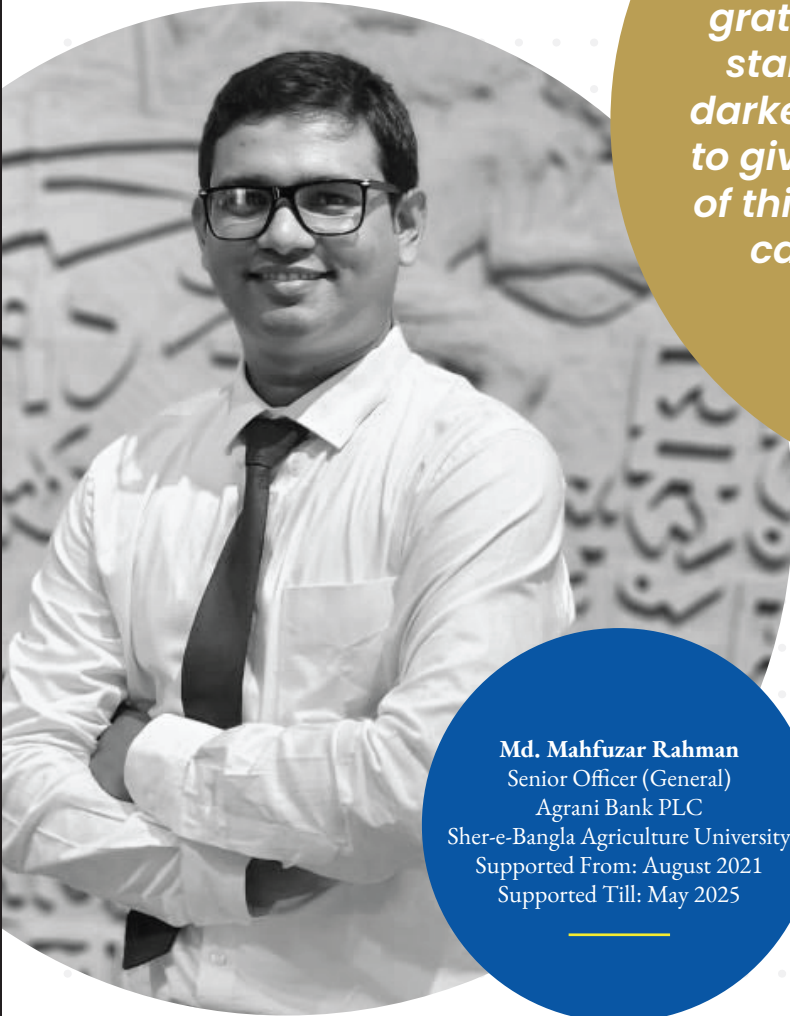
But the city had its own story to tell, a story far more difficult than he had imagined.

Mongla is the second-longest seaport of Bangladesh, very near to the longest mangrove forest Sundarbans. Md Riaz Sheikh lived and grew up here. Riyaz Sheikh is now a student of honors first year in the Chemistry department at the traditional government Prafulla Chandra College, Bagerhat. Riaz Sheikh's story of growing up and coming so far was not as easy as it was told; he had to overcome many ups and downs to come this far in life, and there were many dramas at every turn of his life.

In 2015, when he was in class seven, his father died. Their father's uncertain death brought disaster to their family. With his mother and younger brother, it became difficult to run their family. Due to a lack of money, his dream of pursuing an education was going to be broken. Riaz then decided to go back to the village and join the work.


In the meantime, his mother's sudden decision made their lives more uncertain. She left her sons and married elsewhere and started her new life. Even then, Riaz did not break down and bravely shouldered the responsibility of himself and his younger brother. At first, he started lodging in a carpenter's house. From there, he had to walk for an hour and a half every day to go to school. At this young age, his little legs did not want to walk. Even then, he did not stop going to school. Riyaz studied in the government TA Farooq School and College from class VII to class XII. Despite many struggles in life, he was very talented in his studies. Apart from studies, he participated in various co-curricular activities during his schooling. He used to showcase his talent through competitions such as speech, debate, poetry recitation, Quran recitation, and ghazal. In 2019, he won the highest award of scouting, the 'President Scout Award'. Along with various co-curricular activities, Riaz Sheikh maintained his success in every public examination like PEC, JSC, SSC, and HSC. In each examination, he passed with a GPA of 5.00.



But after the SSC examination, his educational life again fell into uncertainty. Uncertainty began with running the cost of his education in the science department, as well as that of his younger brother. Riaz said, “When I was on the verge of breaking my dream, ‘Shwapnojatra’ stood beside me with a scholarship. 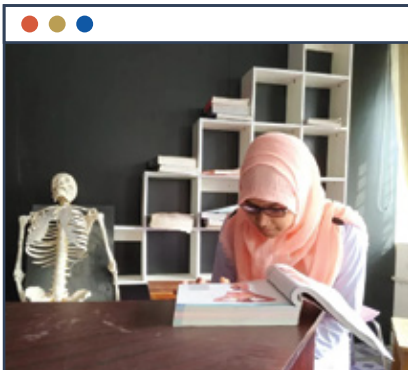
